## Research Study: "Natural Law before Licence " by G. Srinivasan



*"...For example in the 70s, multinational greed enticed millions of Indian mothers to bottle-feed their babies. A sequence of mishaps connected with the use of manufactured baby foods demonstrated that depriving babies of their mother's milk robbed them of immunity to diseases."*

Dr. Srinivasan's treatise, though on the surface seems philosophical, is practical in the way he presents anecdotes on the need to cooperate with nature. The study underlines the fact that natural law is paramount.
